## **Case Study 9: Various Neurological Symptoms**

*Previous diagnosis: Psychogenic*

*Previous course of treatment: prescription, psychiatry*

*Length of treatment: 1 visit*

### **History:**

Patient has severe headaches that are constant from when he wakes up in the morning until he goes to bed at night. He has been experiencing this for years and has seen countless different types of doctors, but hasn't seen any results. The neurological symptoms are driving him insane and they are in clusters that can move around in the jaw and forehead region. He feels as if something is moving around in his face. He has a Parasagittal Meningioma. He has feelings of weird sensations in his face like venetian blinds. He doesn't think I will be able to help him.

### **What was found during her examination:**

- Right superior and posterior positioned Occiput
- C5 RP
- Right and Left TMJ dysfunction
- T1 Left first rib restriction
- T2 anteriorly restricted
- Right Posterior Ilium.
- R suboccipital myospasm

### **Summary of presenting case:**

After treating him one time he noticed 95% improvement in all complaints, except for some remaining occasional pain in the L side of neck that went away quickly.

**End Result- Has a huge reduction in symptoms and is extremely happy.**
